Parent/Guardian Statement of Agreement

Assumption of Risk/Liability Release: I hereby recognize and acknowledge that my child's participation in class activities may involve bodily injuries and/or emotional injury to my child. In consideration of my child being permitted to participate in such events, I hereby voluntarily and knowingly, release, waive and discharge the New London Barn Playhouse from any and all liability (except that caused solely by the negligence of New London Barn Playhouse employees) that may result from my child's participation in class activities.

Emergency Treatment: I hereby authorize New London Barn Playhouse staff to act on my behalf in accordance with their best judgment in case of emergency involving my child, and agree to pay for all expenses, medical or otherwise, that may arise there from. I understand that my insurance company or I will be billed for any such treatment.

Equal Opportunity: The New London Barn provides equal opportunity to participate regardless of race, creed, or gender, and will upon request provide reasonable accommodations to individuals with disabilities.

Media Release: I hereby give permission for employees of the New London Barn to photograph my child during their participation in class activities. Any such photographs may be used by the Barn for non-profit marketing purposes including in print, on the internet, or any other forms of media. The Barn will not sell, loan, or give photographs to any other institution.

Refund: All refunds must be requested on or prior to the first day of the program.

Rules & Expectations

Attendance: Students should plan to attend all class sessions, and be on time for each one. If your child must be absent or late, please give advance notice so as not to disrupt teachers' plans.

Illness: Please don't send us a sick child! In case of absence, let us know as soon as possible by calling 216-390-0174 or emailing andrew@nlbarn.org.

Pick up & drop off: When dropping off your child before class, please be sure to register his or her arrival with the Teacher

or Intensive administrator in the lobby. Please be prompt in picking up your child at the end of each session (5:00 PM on 3/30, and 2:30 PM on 3/31). Children should be picked up by authorized individuals only, and we reserve the right to request photo identification; the Intensive administrator must be notified if someone other than the designated parent/guardian is going to pick them up.

Clothing: Our classes are physical and involve movement, so students should wear comfortable clothes and appropriate foot-gear. (Sneakers and dance shoes are best; bare feet, flip-flops, and crocs are prohibited)

Behavior: We expect that students will behave appropriately and respectfully to staff and fellow class members, and that students will be refrain from excessive roughhousing. If a student exhibits behavior that disrupts the class, including physical or verbal abuse and vandalism, we'll first speak with the student. If the behavior is repeated, we'll contact their designated parent/guardian. If the behavior is repeated a third time, we'll need to dismiss the student from the program without a refund. We expect that our students will learn a lot, be safe, and have a great time at the Barn!
